Dear Ms. Adams,

I am Yukihiisa SHIDA, a Japanese medical doctor who invented a cocktail “Chairperson” in 2004. I requested four head bartenders of the Four Seasons Hotel Paris, Ritz Hotel Paris, Shangri-la Hotel London, and Claridge’s Hotel London to give their comments on the cocktail “Chairperson” and to take a picture with me for my memory and for the record of our academic papers in October and November 2022. Then I was able to meet only Mr. Panos Ntalianis, Head Bartender of Shangri-la Hotel London, and he kindly provided his comment for us, all chairpersons around the world. We met at the bar GONG of Shangri-la Hotel, located on the 52nd floor in London, on October 31, 2022. And the Head Bartender of the Four Seasons Hotel Kuala Lumpur, Mr. Rohan Matmary, didn't meet with me when I asked him to provide a comment on the cocktail “Chairperson” at the main bar of the Four Seasons Hotel Kuala Lumpur in April and June 2023. Unfortunately, the head bartender who is the “Champion Bartender of the Glenfiddich World’s Most Experimental Bartender, India 2018” and the “Champion Bartender of the Diageo World Class Tanqueray Challenge, Global 2021,” doesn't match with me and the cocktail “Chairperson,” just like Mr. Colin Field, the Head Bartender of the Ritz Hotel Paris, who was named “World’s Best Bartender by Forbes in 1997, 2001, and 2004.” [Reference: Academic Papers (F) “Paper on April 3, 2023 (Malaysia)” and “Paper on May 20, 2023 (Malaysia)”]

I have booked a room at the Mandarin Oriental Hotel Bangkok for October 29 and 30, 2023. If possible, I would like to hear your comments on the cocktail “Chairperson” and take a picture with you for my memory and for the record of our academic papers at your main bar, Bamboo Bar. On September 2, 2023, I met Mr. Antonio Lai, Diageo World Class 2015 Hong Kong & Macau Champion Bartender, at the Mandarin Oriental Hotel Tokyo and introduced the cocktail “Chairperson” to him.

As you are the Bar Manager of “One of the top hotels (Burj Al Arab Jumeirah Hotel Dubai, Ritz Hotel Paris, Mandarin Oriental Hotel Bangkok...) around the world,” I would like you to confirm the following facts, unlike the Head Bartenders of the Ritz Hotel Paris and the Four Seasons Hotel Kuala Lumpur, as well as the General Manager of the Four Seasons Hotel Beverly Hills in Los Angeles. On September 26, 2023, a Japanese sports announcer said in a loud voice, “*Korega Sekaiichi no Jitsuryoku-desu!* (This is the No.1 play in the world. She is the best!)” about a Chinese table tennis player who is an Olympic gold medalist when the Women’s Table Tennis Team Finals of the 19th Asian Games in Hangzhou, China was aired.

- # We would like to introduce the cocktail “Chairperson” around the world. If the role that the cocktail “Chairperson” plays is recognized as the pinnacle of a culture free of barriers between men and women by people worldwide from its name, it is nothing but what the cocktail “Chairperson,” the Chairman, and the Chairwoman truly desire as artworks. The cocktail “Chairperson” is also expected to become one of the symbols by which chairpersons around the world will recognize their important role as the “Top of Culture,” given its name and image.
- # The cocktail “Chairperson” has been created by an M.D., Ph.D. (Brilliant: Deviation score is more than 50 in Japan) from a Japanese national university.
- # The cocktail “Chairperson” was adopted as the Olympic cocktail at the China World Hotel Beijing (Shangri-la Hotel group) during the Beijing Olympic Games in 2002.
- # The cocktail “Chairperson” has been introduced to more than 1,000 four- or five-star hotels in the cities around the world.
- # And our cocktail “Chairperson” is a probably the first and only cocktail of its kind in the world.

I am looking forward to meeting you at your main bar during my stay in Bangkok in October 2023.

### **Postscript**

Editorial board member “H” of The Asahi Shimbun (Japan) has posted intense criticisms and opinions about the Bank of Japan Governor Kazuo UEDA on its website titled “Is Governor Ueda Truly a ‘Working Man’? Financial Policy Normalization Limited to Minor Adjustments” (posted on July 28, 2023) and “Will BOJ Governor Ueda Fall into the Same ‘Trap’? Memories and Burdens Behind Caution” (posted on September 25, 2023). These articles were featured on The Asahi Shimbun’s top homepage. Frequently, those who graduated from private universities say in a condescending manner like, “*Daijoubu-desuka?* (Are you «Governor Ueda» okay?)” “*Daijoubu-desuka?* (Are you okay?)” “*Daijoubu* («I ‘H’ am» okay),” “*Daijoubu*. (Okay.)” These phrases are used from a superior standpoint in the Japanese language, and the content is interpreted as “President Ueda’s way of thinking and his work are not worthy of evaluation,” and “President Ueda, who falls into the ‘trap,’ cannot be trusted.” Then, attempts have been made to engage in one-on-one debates questioning whether Governor Kazuo UEDA’s monetary policy is correct or not.

Even at the National University of Tokyo Hospital, when male and female doctors who are graduates of private medical schools are in consultation rooms or examination rooms, they repeatedly ask me, “*Daijoubu-desuka?* (Are you «Dr. Shida» okay?)” “*Daijoubu-desuka?* (Are you okay?)” “*Daijoubu-desuka?*” “*Daijoubu.* (I «Doctor who graduated from private medical university» am okay),” “*Daijoubu.* (I am okay.)” It is not uncommon that individuals who graduated from private universities don’t answer, when I ask them about the names of their own alma mater. And the cost of medical education is a secret. They have graduated from private universities or work for private university hospitals and seem to work without a feeling of tension, and sometimes their conversations can be unfocused. Their crude Japanese “*Chatte,*” “*Chatte*” is also sometimes heard. However, Mr. Kazuo UEDA, the Governor of the Bank of Japan, is an exceptionally talented individual who graduated from the prestigious national University of Tokyo with a high overall score on the entrance examination, equivalent to a “deviation value of 65 in Japan.” He holds a Ph.D. from MIT, a renowned institution and has written academic papers in English on economic topics. He also travels abroad to give lectures and share his expertise. In contrast, Mr. “H,” a member of the editorial board of The Asahi Shimbun, graduated from private Waseda University (Tokyo) that has a dominant atmosphere of mediocrity. His academic performance shows no clear distinction between brilliance and mediocrity as same as President Aiji TANAKA of private Waseda University, who does not seem to distinguish between brilliant (above 50 deviation score) and mediocre (below 50 deviation score) students, graduates and teachers. While Mr. “H” has authored books in Japanese on the Bank of Japan, he has not published English papers and does not appear to engage in overseas (U.S.A, etc.) lectures or teaching activities. Even if he discusses topics solely in Japanese or Thai, his work will not be widely recognized as top-tier.

“H,” an Asahi Shimbun editorial board member, expressed intense criticisms and opinions about Governor Kazuo UEDA, the Bank of Japan. However, it does not seem reasonable that The Asahi Shimbun, which previously appeared to take a stance of being an “opposition party that opposes everything without presenting an alternative,” has prominently featured this on its homepage. It is suggested that The Asahi Shimbun, whose largest academic clique is private Waseda University, first and foremost, should confirm whether the editorial board member “H” has actually presented an alternative proposal (approximately 100 pages in A4 format, in Japanese and English) for Governor Kazuo UEDA’s financial policy. Then, it may be more appropriate for him to publish a statement and advice as an individual, rather than the current approach.

In this context, President Kazuo UEDA is a brilliant with Ph.D. from MIT, known to have achieved a high overall score of “Deviation Value 65” in the prestigious national university entrance examination, and he has been recognized as a world-class professional throughout his successful career. On the other hand, editorial board member “H” holds only a bachelor’s degree from private Waseda University, where the distinction between mediocre students and graduates (Deviation Value below 50) and brilliant students and graduates (Deviation Value 50 or above) isn’t readily obvious. Therefore, it would be better for him to first express his respect for President Kazuo UEDA’s academic background, career and work at the forefront of the world economy, and then express his own intense criticisms and opinions, rather than emotionally looking down on President Ueda. It is also important for him to introduce himself, including his own brilliance or mediocrity, unlike high school or private university graduates. I (Dr. Shida), who have the academic homepage “chairperson.jp,” find myself and my “Doping Backdoor Theory” in a situation much like that of the Governor of the Bank of Japan and his financial policy. In Japan’s medical educational and academic community, including medical societies and among doctors, there have been no alternative proposals put forth. Instead, there are intense criticisms and opinions from the shadows, without even introducing themselves, saying like “Dr. Shida’s way of thinking and work (research, education) are not worthy of evaluation” and “Dr. Shida cannot be trusted,” etc. And, to tell the truth, the cocktail “Chairperson” also received intense criticisms and opinions from the shadows, without even introducing themselves, by saying like “Dr. Shida’s way of thinking and work (art) are not worthy of evaluation” and “Dr. Shida cannot be trusted,” etc. [Reference: Chairperson 20th Anniversary Treatise “Doping - Backdoor Theory since 1999”]

Bar Manager, Mr. Laurent Jeannin (1968-2017), who was acclaimed as the top pâtissier in Paris and died young at the age of 49, once responded to my questions by saying, “It’s easy to criticize others.” Other pâtissiers and critics had criticized him at the time.

朝日新聞社 H 編集委員が「植田総裁は本当に『仕事人』なのか 微修正に留まった金融政策正常化」（2023年7月28日付）及び「植田日銀は同じ『わな』にはまるのか 慎重さの裏にある記憶と重荷」（2023年9月25日付）との Title で日本銀行 植田和男総裁に対する苛烈な批判、ご意見を朝日新聞社の Homepage に掲載されました。私立大学ご出身者からしばしば聞かれます「（植田総裁）大丈夫ですか」「大丈夫ですか」「（私は）大丈夫」「大丈夫」との論調を上から目線で振りかざされ、「植田総裁の考え方、仕事は評価に値しない」「（『わな』にはまる）植田総裁は信用出来ない」と解釈されます内容にて、植田和男総裁は間違っているのではないかと 1 対 1 の論破を試みられています。

国立東京大学附属病院でも、診察室または検査室で私立大学医学士の男性と女性の医師お二人がそれぞれ私国立大学医学博士に「（志田先生）大丈夫ですか」「大丈夫ですか」「（私は）大丈夫」「大丈夫」と繰り返しおっしゃられまして、私立大学出身者は私からご自身のご出身私立大学の名前をお尋ねしてもお答えにならないことが珍しくなく、医学教育費も秘密です。私立大学出身者、私立大学（元）勤務者は「ちゃって」「ちゃって」なども多く緊張感のない仕事をして見え、時にお話がぶれられます。

しかしながら植田和男日本銀行総裁は秀才国立東京大学入学試験で総合成績「偏差値 65 強」を取ってみえる MIT 大学院ご出身の秀才博士。経済に関して英文の Paper を書かれ、講演など海外へ教えに行ってみえます。それに比べて朝日新聞社 H 編集委員は凡才（凡才が支配的な空気の）私立早稲田大学ご出身の学士で、私立早稲田大学 田中愛治総長と同じく総合成績「偏差値 50 強」と「偏差値 50 弱」、すなわち秀才と凡才の区別がついてみえません。日本銀行などに関して日本語の著書は書いてみえるものの、英文の Paper を書いてみえず、米国などの海外へ教授しに（教えに）行ってもみえないご様子です。日本語、Thai 語のみで論述されましても、一流とは評価されません。

その H 編集委員が、日本銀行が今すべき金融政策についての植田和男総裁に対する苛烈なご批判、ご意見を一人で論述されたのですが、かつて「対案を出さず何でも反対の野党」との厳しい論調も展開してみえた朝日新聞社が Homepage Top に載せられたのは理にかなったものではありません。私立早稲田大学が最大学閥の朝日新聞社におかれましても、まず H 編集委員が日本銀行植田和男総裁の金融政策に対する対案（A4 判 100 枚程、日本語、英語）を出されたことを確認された上で、H 編集委員個人による Statement（提言）、Advice を掲載されるのが筋ではないかと考えられます。

その際にも、植田和男総裁は秀才国立大学入学試験で総合成績「偏差値 65 強」を取ってみえる MIT 大学院ご出身の秀才博士でこれまで世界で一流と言われていています仕事をされてますので、凡才（偏差値 50 未満）と秀才（偏差値 50 以上）の区別が付いてみえず凡才が支配的な空気の私立早稲田大学の学士でみえ、自身も秀才と凡才の区別が付いてみえない H 編集委員は、感情的に上から目線ではなく、最初に植田和男総裁の学歴、経歴、仕事に敬意を表された後にご自身からの苛烈な批判、ご意見を述べられた方がよろしいかと存じます。他の高校卒業者や私立大学出身者と同じくご自身の Background について隠す様なことは避けられ、凡才または秀才を含めた自己紹介をされることも大切です。

日本の医学教育学術界におきましては、「chairperson.jp」から拝見しますと私及び「Doping-Backdoor Theory」はまさに日本銀行総裁及び金融政策状態に陥ってしまして、日本の医学教育学術界（学会等）及び医師などは対案も出されず「志田先生の考え方、仕事（研究、教育）は評価に値しない」「志田先生は信用出来ない」など、自己紹介もされず陰から苛烈なご批判、ご意見を述べてみえます。そして実は、Cocktail「Chairperson」も、日本の Bartender さんなど陰から「志田先生の考え方、仕事（芸術）は評価に値しない」「志田先生は信用出来ない」などの苛烈なご批判、ご意見が聞こえて来ています。やはり自己紹介は伴ってみえません。
