Dr. Shida askes Dr. Gordon

I graduated from Mie University and studied "Sports and Medical Education." For example, there are three stories of my research which would be known by about 10 Japanese doctors who attend this seminar today. 1) President of the Japanese Society for Medical Education, Dr. Nobutaro Ban had done special medical education called the "Backdoor" at Kawasaki Medical University. 2) Kyoto University has done special study "Vicious Research" like Dr. Shinya Yamanaka. 3) Two professors of the University of Tokyo expelled me from the Japanese Society of Medical Education in 2015. I am only one doctor who researches "Sports and Medical Education" focusing on the backdoor in Japan. I had asked questions on the backdoor to Harvard University in 2013, Oxford University in 2014 and 2015, and Paris University in 2015 and 2016. The backdoor university uses an intermediator for the entrance examination between a candidate and the university and gathers much money for its education in secret. Nevertheless, the professors of Harvard, Oxford and Paris universities selected "No comment." Do you know any other researcher who focuses on the backdoor like me in the world?

Dr. Gordon replies to Dr. Shida

Ah! Good question. Can I think about this because it's indeed a very interesting question? There is certainly a problem in some universities, some types in the world. I think maybe you are the only researcher (who focuses on the backdoor).

Dr. Shida replies to Dr. Gordon

I am a medical doctor and doctor of medicine, Mie University (Leading university in Mie Prefecture), and have studied medical education since 1999. Incidentally, the University of Tokyo's International Research Center for Medical Education was established in the year 2000. Today's Seminar's theme is the "Post Graduate Medical Education." However, we cannot have a discussion about so-called third-class university in Japan which uses an intermediator between a candidate and the university. Because I, a specialist on the backdoor have received the "Academic Harassment" from the University of Tokyo in the 21st century. And Kyoto University continues the "Vicious Research" like taxi drivers, waiting for customers in front of the National Palace Museum in Taipei. If the University of Tokyo and Kyoto University "kaizen (improve)" their academic attitude, I may have a discussion with you at the congress in Japan. Today, I give only this figure which is indispensable to all discussions of medical education on the earth including this seminar, "The backdoor costs sixty million yen in Japan."

So the following is my view. I came to Kyoto from Tokyo to meet the President of the World Federation for Medical Education today.



You took part in the 48th Annual Meeting of the Japanese Society of Medical Education held at Osaka Medical College last week. But the President and the World Federation for Medical Education don't know about Japanese medical education as same as Mrs. Mariko Hayashi, Japanese famous writer or Mrs. Keiko Hamada, Editor-in-chief of Japanese leading weekly magazine AERA of which price is 390 yen. For example, Osaka Medical College is a "Money-powered Backdoor University," not leading university in Osaka Prefecture. I believe that my research "Sports and Medical Education" on our homepage "chairperson. jp" is useful for the World Federation for



Medical Education to understand Japanese medical education. The University of Tokyo expelled me from the Japanese Society for Medical Education in 2015. However, suppose, just suppose... I was going to show you the way to approach the backdoor that is spread around the world at the conference of the World Federation for Medical Education in the world, but only one theory. Would that be worth something? I hope that the World Federation will consider me as a leader in the field of medical education who focuses on the backdoor, as money-powered universities including Osaka University do (?).
