Dear Mr. Laker,

I stayed at the Mandarin Oriental Hotel in Las Vegas on July 28 and the Fairmont Hotel in Vancouver on July 31, 2018. I appreciate your kindness in allowing me to stay at the Mandarin Oriental Hotel Las Vegas and Fairmont Hotel Vancouver and to give a comment to you, as I did at Osaka University, on August 1, 2018.

Dr. Shida provides an explanation to Mr. Laker

"The Me Too movement started in 2007 and became widespread in 2017. In 2018 Mr. Steve Wynn fell from grace in Las Vegas while a sexual harassment scandal involving Administrative Vice Minister of Finance Junichi Fukuda and a female reporter at TV Asahi, which belongs to the Asahi Shimbun Company ('Real estate company which publishes newspapers') group hit the headlines in Japan. Not only the Asahi Shimbun Company but also all Japanese mass media played it up, denouncing him, the Ministry of Finance and Finance Minister and former Prime Minister Taro Aso, who tried to defend him and the ministry, bitterly. The entire media seemed to have been launching an all-out attack and severe bashing against them as if police had been squaring up to a perpetrator who murdered a police officer. This is an emotionally charged issue that targets the weak, such as women and young people, seen in reports that covered backdoor admissions into Japanese universities, which caused vouths to kill themselves, and one key point was overlooked. In 2018 TV Asahi accused Administrative Vice Minister Fukuda of sexual harassment against its female reporter and at the same time, the Japanese mass media curbed its journalism spirit of protecting the source of information as a journalist that should be observed in developed countries, such as the United States and the United Kingdom (not in China or Russia). General Manager, President Kenzo Tsujimoto of Napa Kenzo Estate and a local taxi driver said that it costs six hundred thousand US \$ to buy a house because there are few residential land in Napa. The theme of my research is 'Sports and Medical Education,' however, Japan's only public broadcast station NHK, just like other mass media, never reported that it costs 70 million yen (more than six hundred thousand US \$) in medical education to buy your way into Fujita Health University (Japan), including donation, via a broker and suppressed the examinees' spirit that those who sit for university exams should be treated equally in the 21st century. Is it only Teikyo University in Japan that is money-powered and conducts backdoor admissions this century? Meanwhile, the U.S. mass media had no problem of reporting that 'Father of California Wine,' Mr. Robert Mondavi (1913-2008) who was Mr. Tim Mondavi's father had contributed a lot of donations to University of California, Davis. NHK (Japan Broadcasting Corporation) President Ryoichi Ueda noted as follows at the press conference when he assumed the office of president on January 25, 2017: 'In order to build an organization in which the sum of motivation of NHK's entire staff maximizes to take up a challenge through concerted efforts, first and foremost, the directors, including myself, must share the common perception of major issues and determines the fundamental direction.' In fact, executives of the International Olympic Committee, including previous chairpersons, share the common recognition of the doping problem and address it as one. As part of the results, it was detected by the World Anti-Doping Agency in 2015 and 2016 that even in the 21st century Russia was involved in state-sponsored doping and covering it up and more than 1,000 athletes of over 30 events were engaged in it, and furthermore, a massive fraud was committed at the Sochi Winter Olympics in 2014 many years after Ben Johnson from Canada was stripped of his gold medal that he won at the Seoul Olympic Games in 1988."
