Dear Assistant General Manager,



I sent a letter about our study to your hotel for the first or second time. I am the Doctor and Chairperson of Sports in Japan. It is my pleasure to introduce our academic homepage **“chairperson. jp”** which is visited from all over the world including China (?). For your information, I have informed about the **“Chairperson 20th Anniversary Treatise”** which is an unconventional style (not a full paper style) to the professors of the University of Tokyo in 2012, Harvard University in 2013, Oxford University in 2014 and Paris University in 2015 for the **“Doping-Backdoor Theory,”** the general managers or assistant general managers of hundreds of four or five-star hotels around the world for the **“Chairperson Cocktail”** and the regular members of the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra for **“My Way”** in (2010 and) 2016. “There are one and only theory and cocktail for universities and hotels in the 21st century.”

They dropped their head abruptly towards your reference, Fukushima University and my old school, Mie which do not use the entrance-examination broker and 90% of the

I lived in Kawaguchi-city in Saitama Prefecture (2003-2018) and have been living in Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo (2018-), and working as a M.D. and Ph.D. of Mie National University (Mie Prefecture). In 2011, the late Yoshio UCHINO, president of a long-term care health facility in Kawaguchi-city and vice-president of Tokyo Medical University, said to me (Dr. Shida, part-time doctor at the facility) to suppress the fact (Tokyo Medical University is a backdoor university), “Our facility received a claim that patient referral documents prepared by you (Dr. Shida) were not complete from a nearby hospital. Then our nurse had to give more information about the patient to the hospital.” I told the head nurse about this trouble, “The doctor of the hospital mistook me for a doctor who is a backdoor doctor from Tokyo Medical University, because Dr. Uchino asked me not to write my name, ‘Dr. Yukihsa SHIDA (Ph.D. of Mie University)’ in the patient referral documents.” As your assistant general manager knows, 7 years later, Tokyo Medical University became one of the most famous backdoor universities around the world in the 21st century. And I would like to request that your hotel will not mistake me for a doctor who is a graduate of a private medical university, like Yokohama Baycourt Club and Kahala Hotel Yokohama did on January 3, 2021.
