Dr. Shida provides an explanation to Mr. Kim

"I sometimes have an opportunity to work with former or present teachers of the Japanese private universities as a part-time physician in the Tokyo Metropolitan area. Professor Emeritus Hideaki Mizoguchi, Tokyo Women's Medical University had an attractive empty talk during a seminar of the Japanese Red Cross Society, Professor Hiroshi Tanaka and his medical team of Juntendo University usually talk vulgar jokes at medical meetings. Dr. Kazuhiro Otsuka, Professor of Teikyo University is a criminal who sexually harassed a woman and put his poster with the F.C.TOKYO, a soccer Team, on display in front of the consulting room in the hospital in spite of making the space look bad. Dr. Yoshio Uchino, Professor Emeritus of Tokyo Medical University didn't write patients' clinical records for three months. Dr. Tsuneto Akashiba, Professor of Nihon University conducted impolite lectures ('Shinjatta'...) about patients on a podium during the Japan Medical Association Program, just like Dr. Takenori Mishiba, Professor of Kinki University speaks in a childlike tone ('Chatte'...). Still, you are seldom able to see these low-level daily medical treatment in a TV program in Japan, looking like low-level daily service ('Daijoubudesuka?'...) at Yodobashi Akihabara which announces 'we give No.1 service to our customers' in its biggest electronics store in Tokyo, because Dr. Kazuhiko Yamamoto, Associate Professor of St. Marianna University School of Medicine suppresses ('Osaeru') disclosure and inspection of their unstable medical treatment in private universities in the 'Not Brilliant and Backdoor' atmosphere at the Japan Medical Education Association in the 21st century."
