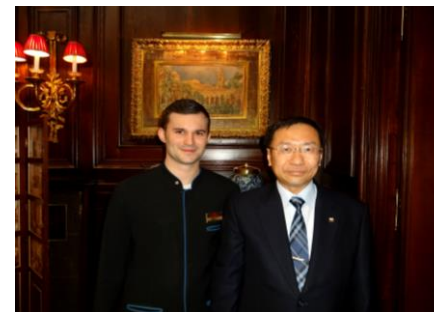
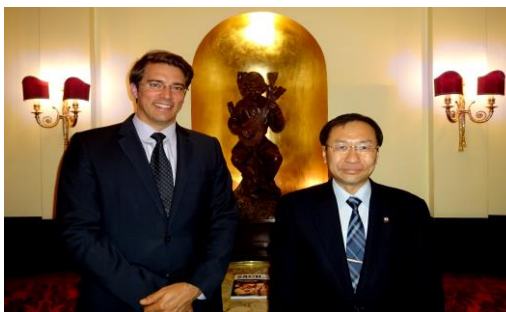

Dear Mr. Habicher,

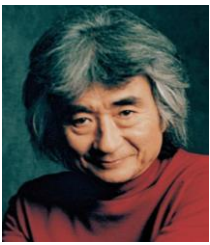
I stay at the Imperial Hotel in Vienna on May 23, 2016. I appreciate your kindness in allowing me to stay at the Imperial Hotel and to give a comment to you, as I did at Osaka University, on May 23, 2016.

Dr. Shida provides an explanation to Mr. Heilmann and Mr. Habicher

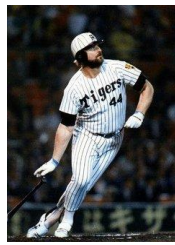
“I (Yukihisa SHIDA, M.D., Ph.D., Mie University) have asked the University of Tokyo (public university) on our study many times, then they said ‘No comment (No response)’ repeatedly in the 21st century. The reasons are the following current status, their ‘Habits (*Shuukan* or *Kuse*),’ 1) Prof. Kazuhiko Yamamoto has been a backdoor (‘run wild’) doctor since 1993, like the Okinaga family of Teikyo University (Japan). 2) Prof. Hijiri Kitamura did not tell public universities (brilliant) from private universities (not-brilliant) in Japan in 2011. He could not say that Dr. Shida is a Mie University graduate in spite of the fact that my old school, Mie University (public university) is different from Aichi Medical University or Jikei University (both private backdoor universities). 3) Probably, Prof. Hiromi Sanada has ‘low level of humanity’ in 2012 as same as doctors who like nurses in Japan. 4) (Former) Prof. Hisashi Moriguchi did not tell doctors and medical staffs (nurses...) in 2012. ‘Was he a medical doctor? So (*Sou*)??’ 5) Prof. Jeffrey Wong could not understand ‘Academic Harassment’ in 2013. 6) Prof. Tetsuo Tsuji did not know the ordinary (*‘Ippan*’) persons, students, bachelors, masters and doctors in 2015. Mr. Tsuji and most Vice-Ministers of 11 Japanese ministries know the score (*‘Kireru*’) as a professional, but no experience of doctor. 7) Prof. Kohei Maezono and Prof. Nobuhito Saito were seen to be ‘Greenhorns’ in 2015. And many professors of the University of Tokyo don’t have enough global mindset in the academic field like most professors of Mie University. [Our study is not only for Japanese but also for people of the world in the 21st century.] Furthermore, the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra had also rejected my question on November 16, 2009. ‘Mr. Seiji Ozawa, who is highly acclaimed in the U.S.A. and Japan, took the post of music director of the Winer Staatsoper. He received many strict (*‘Kibishii*’) booning from the audience and music critics in Vienna who are particularly attached to classical music. Because of the fact that Mr. Ozawa had lacked experiences as conductor of an orchestra for opera, he could not become a true leader of the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra which consists of more than 100 extremely talented and individual members. We, Japanese, get such an impression. How do you think about it? Could you please give us your frank opinion?’ General Manager, I said to Mr. Michael Anthony, ‘New York City’s Best Chef (2012)’ on November 14, 2012. ‘I will send my ‘Chairperson 20th Anniversary Treatise’ to more than 30 four- or five-star hotels in New York in 2013, and hope that the American citizens will accept that in the 21st century. U.S. Senator Randy Bass, former professional baseball player who played in the USA and Japan, commented in 1998, ‘Mr. Suguru Egawa of the Tokyo Yomiuri Giants is the best pitcher in Japan (because he had not given me an intentional walk unlike most Japanese pitchers).’ ”
