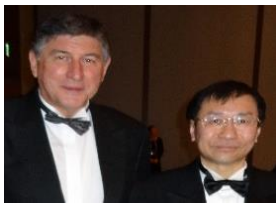
Dear Mr. Le Calvez,

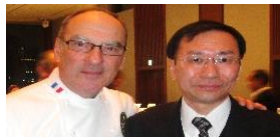
Mr. Stephen Boxall: General Manager of the Ritz Hotel London (January 24, 2015)

Dr. Shida provides an explanation to Mr. Boxall and Mr. Le Calvez

“For No.1 sightseeing city, Paris, we would like to request the Élysée Palace to improve the manners of French taxi drivers (not one person) who drive sometimes shouting at other taxi drivers in Paris. This story is similar to the doctors (Professor Masahiko Kaito, Associate Professor Motoo Iwasa...), graduates of Mie University Faculty of Medicine School of Medicine, who yelled at me (Doctor and Chairperson of Sports) and laghed foolishly (*‘Herahera’*) in the hospital in Mie prefecture, Japan. [They (not one person) researched Hepatology based on the white clinical records as a board certified as specialist. And the Japan Society of Hepatology and *Asahi Shimbun* could not confirm this fact.] On the other hand, black taxi drivers’ behavior is said to be generally good in London. Mr. Takashi Kako is a famous Japanese pianist who graduated from the Paris Conservatoire in 1976 where he studied on a scholarship from the French government with the Prix de Composition. He was awarded the Prize for the Best Artistic Contribution at the Montreal World Film Festival in 1998. He had announced that he would hold a private salon concert for his fan club members in the near future. I have been a member of his circle (free charge) and bought his concert tickets and CDs for a total of hundred thousand yen (one thousand US\$), but since he stopped sending his circle’s e-mails to me, I have never heard about the salon concert for the last ten years. Dr. Kazuomi Kario, Professor of Jichi Medical University (private near first-class university, Japan) and Visiting Professor (2004) of Columbia University, who is described as one of the opinion leaders on hypertension disease in Japan, saw me (Dr. Shida) at the forum at the Nikko Hotel Narita International Airport (Japan) on July 6, 2013. He commented me (Doctor and Chairperson of Sports) about the ‘Medical care without a sense of tension’ (A doctor watches TV before 9am or after 5pm in his president room of the hospital. Nurses use an antihypertensive drug for a patient with cerebral hemorrhage in the acute stage to control his «systolic» blood pressure below 130 mmHg...etc.) by the doctors from private universities (Jichi Medical University, Toho University «private third-class university»...etc.) with the impolite way of eating, putting his hand in his pocket. Can we afford to offer awards, posts or budgets to these impolite (*“Shitsurei”*) persons? Dr. Takashi Ejiri, Jichi Medical University alumni fired me in 1993 for the following reasons; 1) Dr. Shida didn’t start his work at 8:30am (regular working time start at 9:00am) in the hospital unlike a young doctor who graduated from Jichi Medical University, 2) Dr. Shida did not answer his patient’s past history perfectly at once. General Manager, who is well-versed in art, gourmet, fashion, business and research, we need to have good manners like the polished gentlemen in London and Parisians. Mr. Philippe Sauzedde who served President of France, Mr. François Mitterrand and Japanese Emperor Hirohito in 1982 advised us that the manner of putting man’s hand in his pocket is not good on September 10, 2014. Of course, Moët & Chandon Mr. Marc Brevet flatly denied this rumor on the Moët & Chandon group with his full of confidence on November 6, 2009, a curator of a small art museum in Japan on December 14, 2004 told me ‘A ferocious dog bit top wine critics, Mr. Robert Parker’s lower limb to change his evaluation on the champagne or wine made by the Moët & Chandon group.’”

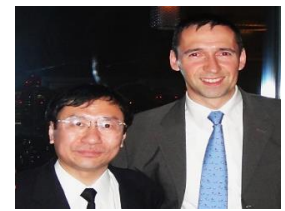
