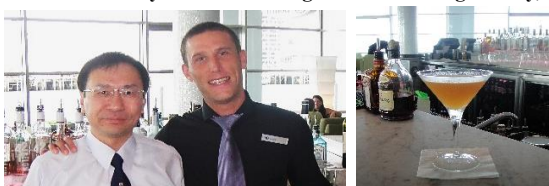
Dear Mr. Mascarenhas,

I stay at the Langham Hotel in Auckland on April 26, 2015. I appreciate your kindness in allowing me to stay at the Langham Hotel and to give a comment to you, as I did at Osaka University, on April 26, 2015.

Mr. Franz Mascarenhas: General Manager of the Langham Hotel Auckland (April 26, 2015)

Dr. Shida provides an explanation to Mr. Mascarenhas

“ ‘All Blacks.’ All players of rugby teams appreciate ‘ferns (or *shida* in Japanese).’ I (Dr. Shida) appreciate both All Blacks and ferns (*shida*), too. And I asked the following question to seven bars of the five or four-star hotels in Auckland on January 24, 2011: ‘Have you ever heard of ‘Chairperson Cocktail and Dr. Shida’?’ Though I also visited the Hilton Hotel Auckland where the New Zealand No.1 Bartender worked and SKYCITY which held a cocktail seminar, I could not meet a bartender who answered ‘Yes, I (we) know the ‘Chairperson Cocktail and Dr. Shida’ in Auckland. There was no bar which knew the world’s bar scene of the 21st century to use English language. I (Dr. Shida) think that about 20 or 30% (??) of five or four-star hotels recognize the ‘Chairperson Cocktail and Dr. Shida,’ and about 20 or 30% (??) of first-class or near first-class universities maybe recognize ‘Doping-Backdoor Theory and Dr. Shida’ in the permanent members of the U.N. Security Council. Unfortunately, the backdoor of Oxford University in 2002 is known by many first-class or near first-class universities including the University of Auckland. Furthermore, Dr. John Hood, a graduate of Auckland University, was in charge of Oxford University as a Vice-Chancellor (Chairperson) from 2004 until 2009. In this respect, our ‘Chairperson Cocktail since 2004’ or ‘Doping-Backdoor Theory since 1999’ have not yet been known throughout the world like the ‘All Blacks,’ but can compare with the penetration rate (approximately 20 or 30% «??») for the ‘Backdoor of Oxford University’ in the world today. General Manager, (former) Mayor of Kyoto city, Mr. Yorikane Masumoto said ‘Kyoto University is our (citizen’s) honor.’ Contrary to its idea of ‘We (Nihon University) have one million peers (*Nakama*),’ most Japanese neither ‘appreciate (*Ichimokuoku*)’ Nihon University nor care its vulgar talks and laughs daily, same as other third-class universities in Japan, Juntendo University (students, Prof. Hiroshi Tanaka...) etc.”
