Dear Assistant General Manager,

This is the first time for me to send a letter about our study to your hotel. I am the Doctor and Chairperson of Sports in Japan. It is my pleasure to introduce our academic homepage “**chairperson.jp**” which is visited from all over the world excluding China (?). For your information, I have informed about the “**Chairperson 20th Anniversary Treatise**” which is an unconventional style (not a full paper style) to the professors of the University of Tokyo in 2012, Harvard University in 2013, Oxford University in 2014 and Paris University in 2015 for the “**Doping-Backdoor Theory**,” the general managers or assistant general managers of hundreds of four or five-star hotels around the world for the “**Chairperson Cocktail**” and the regular members of the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra for “**My Way**” in (2010 and) 2016. “There are one and only theory and cocktail for universities and hotels in the 21st century.”

However, Mr. Kishida and Japanese mass media ignored Japanese voices this winter in 2022, saying “We (Japanese people) need a discussion about the timing and how much Japan's defense budget would increase.” Prime Minister Kishida announced that the government will increase Japan's defense budget by 1.5 times in December 2022 abruptly without listening to Japanese people's opinions. (“NHK News 7” of the Broadcasting Corporation, Japan reported this truth «Japanese voice» in December 2022.) To make matters worse, his ability to ask if someone is brilliant or mediocre is poor, because he is a graduate of private Waseda University where 20~30% of undergraduates is mediocre and mediocrities are dominant.
