Dear Mr. Pedersen,

I stay at the InterContinental Hotel Hong Kong on July 2, 2017. I appreciate your kindness in allowing me to stay at the InterContinental Hotel Hong Kong and to give a comment to you, as I did at Osaka University, on July 2, 2017.

Dr. Shida provides an explanation to Mr. Pedersen

“I said to Mr. Alessandro Cozzolino, Italian Chef of the Grand Hyatt Hotel Hong Kong on February 4, 2017. ‘In my local Mie Prefecture in Japan, Akafuku Co., Ltd. was established in 1707 and have made Akafuku Mochi (a pounded rice cake topped with a sweet bean paste) near the territory of the Ise Grand Shrine. It was revealed that Akafuku caused a big problem by falsifying its best before dates in Japan in 2007. I told a clinical and research fraud (study based on many blank clinical records) by a doctors’ group of Mie University (brilliant, near first-class public university, Mie Prefecture) who studied liver disease to The Asahi Shimbun in Mie Prefecture in 1996. On the other hand, he (Dr. Shida) graduated from Aichi Medical University (not-brilliant, money-powered backdoor, hence third-class private university, Aichi Prefecture) and is less reliable in Mie Prefecture.’ So, he told me, ‘I, a journalist of The Asahi Shimbun trusted the doctors’ group of Mie University who studied liver disease more than you (Dr. Shida).’ Chef, please let us confirm that I (Dr. Shida) am a brilliant medical doctor who passed the examination to test scholastic ability of Fukushima University (near first-class public university) in 1983 and Doctor of Medicine who graduated from Mie University Graduate School in 1992. I will be pleased if you trust me at not only the Roppongi Hills Club Japan but also in Japan, like you are trusted at not only the Grand Hyatt Hotel Hong Kong but also in Hong Kong in the 21st Century despite of the dishonorable scandal of the general manager of the Grand Hyatt Hotel Tokyo in 2014.’ Indeed, there is no explanation on websites of Aichi Medical University and Fujita Health University in Aichi Prefecture next to Mie Prefecture like Teikyo University’s website (famous backdoor university in the 21st century) that they have received forty million yen education expense from brilliant doctors, and gathered more than sixty million yen education expense in total from not-brilliant doctors including foreign doctors coming to Japan to study from Asian countries to use the entrance-examination broker in secret before they passed the National Medical Practitioners Qualifying Examination. An office worker of third-class private university insisted that we must protect private information on our doctors as a professional. Then, we should be careful that it is often difficult to tell brilliant doctors (*Shusai*) from mediocrity (*Bonsai*, between brilliant and dark) backdoor doctors at private universities in Japan. General Manager, ‘It is not the best reception for not only the patients, doctors, pharmacists, nurses and medical staff but also for citizens and foreigners at their private universities’ homepages.’ I am also a graduate of Aichi Medical University Faculty of Medicine who spent forty million yen and brilliant (*Shuusai*) doctor, so, different from many backdoor graduates of Aichi Medical University who paid sixty million yen and are mediocrity (*Bonsai*) doctors and members of the Alumni Association of Aichi Medical University this century.”
