There were some news from the U.S. District Court in California and Hawaii....in 2017 and 2018. In a mediation conference with respect to succession of property of an elder brother of Dr. Shida's father (legacy totaling about 350 million yen (3.11 million US dollars, as of October 30, 2018) to be divided by 10 people of the Shida Family) held at the Tsu Family Court in Dr. Yukihisa Shida's hometown (Mie Prefecture, Japan) on October 15, 2018, a judicial scrivener of the Tsu Family Court at the court talked loudly for more than one minute one-sidedly, cutting me off, right in front of me, Dr. Shida, who was the party concerned in the mediation. “I (judicial scrivener) did nothing wrong and nobody will replace me as the person in charge,” he said. Given the fact that the mediator at a court interrupted level-head mediation procedures, I must say that this is considered to be an error (“*Kashi*”) committed by the Tsu Family Court in Japan and I thus notified the court of this in writing on October 21, 2018.
