To the Secretariat of the 58th Annual Meeting of the Japan Society for Medical Education

I hope this message finds you well.

My name is Yukihiisa Shida, M.D., Ph.D. (National Mie University, Japan), and a former member of the Japan Society for Medical Education.

Regarding the academic documents I previously sent to the Japan Society for Medical Education—namely, the document dated May 30, 2015, “Paper on May 30, 2015 (Japan Society for Medical Education)” and the document dated September 17, 2025, “Paper on September 17, 2025 (Japan Society for Medical Education)”—it appears that I have not yet received any confirmation of receipt from the Society. I would be grateful if I could receive a response from the Board of Directors.

Please note that Dr. Akiteru TAKAMURA, Congress President (a graduate of National Mie University Graduate School and Professor at National Toyama University «Toyama Prefecture, Japan»), previously served as an Associate Professor at Private Kanazawa Medical University (Kanazawa Prefecture, Japan), a money-powered backdoor university (using an entrance-exam broker and costing over 60 million yen «approx. USD 375,000 at an exchange rate of 160 yen to the dollar»). Therefore, from the perspective of conflict of interest, please ensure he is excluded from handling this matter.

Additionally, on July 27, 2026, at a pharmaceutical presentation held at my full-time hospital in Saitama City by Abbott Japan Co., Ltd.—which develops and manufactures the enteral nutrition formula Ensure—a case report was presented claiming that an Abbott employee personally used their own product and successfully lost weight.

In response, I asked the presenter from Abbott: “Did anyone not point out Abbott’s conflict of interest during your presentation at the National Defense Medical College Hospital in Saitama Prefecture?” and “Is conflict of interest not being discussed within Abbott?”

On its website, Abbott states, “Abbott’s efforts to foster a wonderful work environment have been highly recognized, receiving numerous awards both domestically and internationally, and earning support from a wide range of people as an employer of choice. Furthermore, it has been selected annually as one of Fortune magazine’s ‘World’s Most Admired Companies’ every year since 1984.” However, much like the Japan Society for Medical Education, its internal organizational transparency may, in fact, be poor.

Furthermore, as members of the Japan Society for Medical Education are well aware, elementary school-level medical practice is not uncommon within the Japanese medical community. However, at chairperson.jp—unlike certain physicians or lawyers associated with national Okayama University—our research is not conducted using elementary school-level methods such as childish phrasing (“*chatte*” or “*chatta*”). We are not a third-rate “rain cloud,” but a first-rate “vapor trail.” On the June 27, 2026 broadcast of TBS (Tokyo Broadcasting System Television)’s *Hodo Tokushu*, the female news anchor remarked, “I received the impression that careful discussions regarding SNS slander and defamation are taking place in the Miyagi Prefectural Assembly.” From an elementary school level perspective, however, the impression is rather one of “careless discussions.”

Regrettably, I have not yet received any notification from the Society’s Board of Directors indicating that the pending issues I have presented and published on chairperson.jp—as “probably the world’s only expert on backdoor university admissions” (President of the World Federation for Medical Education, London)—such as “Medical Education Costs Exceeding 60 Million Yen at Japanese Private Medical Schools,” “The Doping-Backdoor Theory,” and “Academic Harassment by the University of Tokyo and Kyoto University,” have been accepted by the Japan Society for Medical Education and that the necessary discussions will be conducted.

For your reference, I have also sent an academic document titled “Paper on January 1, 2024 (Keio University, Japan)” to Private Keio University, a private institution. Below, I present cases 1) and 2) as examples demonstrating that Keio University, much like the Japan Society for Medical Education, has failed to take appropriate action in terms of university education.

1. At my former full-time hospital (239 beds) in Chiba Prefecture in the Tokyo Metropolitan, there was a graduate of Keio University who worked as a regular part-time physician. During lunchtime, this physician consistently ignored a posted notice asking staff to “Please close the dining hall door” and repeatedly left it wide open by hand. This request was a gesture of consideration from the hospital’s nutrition department toward outpatient visitors, designed to prevent dining odors and staff conversations from reaching the adjacent outpatient waiting area. It was truly regrettable for the patients sitting in the waiting area—many of whom were physically or mentally weakened, or fasting for health checkups and other medical examinations—who had to endure such discomfort.

While daily typographical errors related to brain anatomy (such as writing “frontal use” instead of “frontal lobe”) were not uncommon in referral letters sent to my former full-time hospital from physicians at Private Teikyo University Hospital (Tokyo Metropolitan Area), another private institution, a re-examination of the poster on the dining hall door clearly showed the instructions “Strictly No Leaving Open” and “Be Sure to Close.” This graduate of Keio University was unable to read not only the main text itself, but also between the lines: “Do not lower the standard of medical care to the level of private universities, and do not cause trouble for the hospital, the patients, or their families.”

2. Incident at the Sushi Bar in the Roppongi Hills Club, Japan (51st floor, Roppongi Hills Mori Tower in Tokyo) on the evening of May 14, 2024. At a sushi restaurant with only 10 counter seats, a group of about four men and women associated with Keio University were loudly conversing, repeatedly mentioning “Keio University” and “Keio” in voices that echoed throughout the establishment for over an hour. Meanwhile, a mature couple seated right next to me at the counter spoke briefly in voices so low I could barely hear them; the atmosphere clearly indicated that I was not the only guest appalled by the poorly mannered Keio University group.

Incidentally, over the past decade since I joined the Roppongi Hills Club in May 2016, there have been only two occasions at the sushi bar where I was subjected to guests talking in loud voices that echoed through the room—including this group from Keio University. On the first occasion, two male guests did not mention their university affiliation, but their loud voices similarly echoed throughout the premises for over an hour, behaving as though they had rented out the entire sushi bar for themselves.

While it is regrettable that a Ph.D. from national Mie University must repeatedly issue warnings to private Keio University, luxury hotels and high-end restaurants—such as Golden Lion (Imperial Hotel Tokyo) and the Roppongi Hills Club—are routinely utilized by wealthy individuals conducting business worth hundreds of millions of yen. They are not places for second-rate guests, such as Keio University faculty, to engage in elementary school-level classroom disruptions. First and foremost, they need to learn from the top-tier economics practiced by upper-class elites. For instance, elite individuals despise wasting time on coarse, vulgar topics that lump people together simply as “Keio Boy,” “Keio Girl,” or “Keio,” fail to distinguish between physicians and nurses, or fail to differentiate genuine brilliance from mediocrity.

Finally, on a side note: at exclusive domestic and international dinners and parties (such as black-tie events) gathered by wealthy upper-class elites, scholars from the Japan Society for Medical Education who lack fine dining experience, displaying vulgar and unsightly manners and despicable academic harassment such as chicken-like body movements and poor musical performances are by no means welcome. I trust that the Society's leadership—including President Hiroshi Nishigori (former Lecturer at the University of Tokyo, former Associate Professor and current Specially Appointed Professor at Kyoto University, and current Professor at Nagoya University)—and other officers will sincerely acknowledge the historical facts concerning themselves and carefully, calmly exercise appropriate self-restraint and discretion.

Allow me to reiterate that, unlike physicians belonging to the *San-ikai* (Alumni Association of the School of Medicine, National Mie University), I do not conduct research based on blank medical records. Furthermore, my medical education and instruction are not based on elementary school-level medicine, that is, the vulgar, unsightly work attitudes—resembling chickens—the elementary school-level spoken language, or the habits of playing video games and watching anime during working hours exhibited by three “mediocre” private Tokyo Medical University physicians, including the hospital director at my full-time hospital (91 beds, Saitama City). I explicitly state these facts for clarification in lieu of concluding remarks:

“I hope to work together with all of you (members of the Japan Society for Medical Education) to build a community that is warm toward others, sharp in logic, meticulous in language, respectful of reflection, values freedom and independence, stands up against authority when necessary, remains tolerant, and takes proactive action for better education.” (From the website of the Japan Society for Medical Education)

After having served as a faculty member at The National University of Tokyo and National Kyoto University for many years—during which his colleagues engaged in vulgar, hideous manners and despicable academic harassment, such as chicken-like physical movements and poor musical performances—Professor Hiroshi NISHIGORI of National Nagoya University, who served as a former lecturer at the University of Tokyo and a former associate professor and current specially appointed professor at Kyoto University, was elected President of the Japan Society for Medical Education in August 2024. In October 2025, he was also selected as one of the Karolinska Institutet Prize for Research in Medical Education (KIPRIME) Fellows 2025, an honor awarded to researchers with internationally outstanding achievements; indeed, it appears that vulgar and hideous manners alongside despicable academic harassment, including chicken-like physical movements and poor musical performances, have led directly to these international achievements.

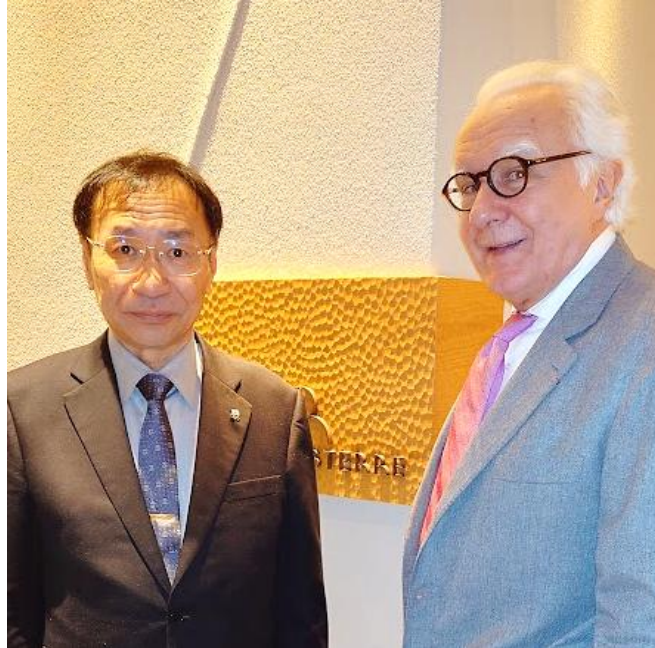

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Afterword

Thank you for your continued support. I became a member of the Japan Society for Medical Education on August 31, 2009, and have continued as a member for the past five years, but I would like to withdraw from the organization as of May 30, 2015. One of the main reasons why I am withdrawing from the Japan Society for Medical Education is to stop any further academic harassment from this organization toward me (Yukihisa Shida, M.D., Ph.D. [Mie University]), harassment that has continued after publication of the Chairperson 20th Anniversary Treatise on January 26, 2012. I have received the “Academic Harassment” from the Sanikai (Alumni Association of Mie University Faculty of Medicine) over 20 years. So if my current work in internal medicine decreases, I will not have enough savings for my life in old age. Therefore, I regret to inform you that due to this academic harassment, it will become difficult for me to complete the full paper for the Chairperson 20th Anniversary Treatise that I had planned to finish by 2022. Furthermore, as a member of the Japan Society for Medical Education, I would like to mention the following points to the organization:

The above is the preface to my letter addressed to the Board of Directors of the Japan Society for Medical Education on May 30, 2015, titled “Paper on May 30, 2015 (Japan Society for Medical Education).” Thanks to all of your “support,” by resigning from the society, I was able to increase my internal medicine shifts in the Tokyo Metropolitan Area. Furthermore, with the addition of the inheritances from my parents and uncle received between 2018 and 2020, as of today, July 31, 2026—11 years after my resignation on May 30, 2015—I have permanently secured a lifetime income of over 20 million yen (approx. USD 125,000 at an exchange rate of 160 yen to the dollar) per year as my retirement funds, equivalent to that of a professor at the Graduate School of Medicine, The National University of Tokyo.

過去日本医学教育学会宛お送りしました学術文書、2015 年 5 月 30 日付文書「Paper on May 30, 2015 (Japan Society for Medical Education)」と 2025 年 9 月 17 日付文書「Paper on September 17, 2025 (Japan Society for Medical Education)」につきまして、これまで一度も学会から受領のご連絡をいただけていない様ですので、学会理事会からご一報いただければ幸いです。なお高村昭輝学術大会会長（国立三重大学大学院卒業、国立富山大学教授）は、「(入試 Broker を使い、6 千万円以上出す) 裏口金権大学」私立金沢医大の元准教授でもみえますため、利益相反の面から今回の事案からは外れてもらって下さい。

ちなみに 2026 年 7 月 27 日には、経腸栄養剤エンシュアの開発・製造もしてみえる Abbott Japan 社によります常勤病院（さいたま市）での薬剤説明会にて、「Abbott の社員自身が、自社製品を摂取し Diet に成功しました」との Case Report を提示されましたため、「国立防衛医大病院（埼玉県）での説明会では、Abbott 社の利益相反を指摘されませんでしたか」「Abbott 社内では、利益相反について議論をしてみえないのですか」と、Abbott 社の Presenter にお話させていただきました。

なお日本医学教育学会の先生方が知ってみえます様に、日本の医学界では小学生 Level の医療が珍しくありませんが、chairperson.jp では国立岡山大学の医師、弁護士などとは異なり、「ちゃって」「ちゃった」等小学生 Level の Method では Research を進めておらず、三流の「雨雲」ではなく一流の「ひこうき雲」です。2026 年 6 月 27 日 TBS「報道特集」では、女性 Caster が、「宮城県議会では、SNS 上の誹謗中傷について丁寧な議論がなされている、との印象を受けました」と番組内で述べてみえましたが、小学生 Level では「雑な議論」の印象です。

「恐らく、世界で唯一の大学裏口入試の専門家」(President of the World Federation for Medical Education、London) として chairperson.jp で発表し、公表しています「日本の私立大学医学部における 6,000 万円以上の医学教育費」「The Doping-Backdoor Theory」「国立東京大学並びに国立京都大学による Academic Harassment」等の懸案事項につきまして、日本医学教育学会におきまして採択となり、必要な議論がなされますというご連絡は、残念ながら未だ学会理事会から受け取っておりません。ご参考までに、私、私立慶應義塾大学へも学術文書「Paper on January 1, 2024 (Keio University, Japan)」をお送りしてまして、慶應義塾大学も、日本医学教育学会と同様、大学教育のご対応をしてみえない実例としまして、下記 1) 2) をご紹介させていただきます。

- 1) 私の前 常勤病院 (239 床、千葉県) に慶應義塾大学卒業生 (定期非常勤医師) がみえましたが、昼食時、「職員食堂の扉を閉めて下さい」との Poster 掲示を無視され、何度も手で開けっ放しにしていってしまいました。昼食の匂い、職員同士の話し声が、職員食堂から隣の外来待合室の患者さんに届かないための、病院栄養課から外来患者さんへの配慮なのですが、外来待合室で座ってみえる、しばしば体力、気力が弱ってみえる患者さん、健康診断等の検査のため絶食中の患者さんは、つらい想いをされお気の毒でした。

私立帝京大学病院の医師からの前 常勤病院宛紹介状には日常誤植 (「前頭葉」が「前頭用」など) が珍しくありませんでしたが、食堂入口扉に貼ってあります Poster を改めて見直しますと「開放厳禁」「必ず閉める」との記載です。慶應義塾大学の卒業生は、本文と共に、その行間「医療 Level を (私立大学並みに) 落として、病院、患者さん、患者さんの家族へ迷惑を掛けしないで下さい」を読むことがお出来になりませんでした。

- 2) 2024 年 5 月 14 日夜、六本木 Hills Club (六本木森 Tower 51F) ・ 鮎 Bar での出来事です。Counter10 席の寿司 Restaurant ですが、「慶應大学」「慶應」と大きな声でお話になる慶應義塾大学関係者 男女 4 名程の Group が、店内に響き渡る大きな声で 1 時間以上お話になってみえました。なお私のすぐ隣の Counter 席に掛けてみえたもう一組の熟年 Couple は、私にも聞こえないぐらいの小さな声で短く話してみえ、Manner の悪い慶應義塾大学 Group に閉口していました Guest は私一人だけではない空気でした。ちなみに私 2016 年 5 月に六本木 Hills Club に入会以降の過去 10 年間で、鮎 Bar にて店内に響き渡る大きな声で話してみえる Guest とご一緒させていただいたのは、慶應義塾大学からの男女 Group を含め 2 回のみです。1 回目の Guest 男性お二人は大学名は話してはみえませんでした、大声が 1 時間以上店内に響き渡ってみえまして、同じく鮎 Bar がご自身達で貸し切りの様な立ち振る舞いでみえました。

私立慶應義塾大学には、国立三重大学医学博士から再三のご注意になりまして恐縮なのですが、Golden Lion (帝国 Hotel 東京)、六本木 Hills Club などの高級 Hotel、高級 Restaurant は、日常億単位の Business を行っています富裕層が普通に利用してしまして、慶應義塾大学教官などの二流の Guest が小学生 Level の学級崩壊をするところではありません。まず、上流階級の Elite における一流の経済学を見習っていただく必要があります。例えば、「慶應 Boy」「慶應 Girl」「慶應」とひとくくりにする、医師と看護師を区別しない肥溜めくさい話、秀才と凡才を区別しないあほくさい話など、時間の無駄になることは嫌います。

最後に余談ですが、上流階級の富裕層が集う国内外の Exclusive な Dinner & Party (Black Tie など) では、一流 Restaurant での Dinner 経験の少なさが露呈し、普段鶏の様な身体運動、下手な演奏活動等、下品で醜い Manner 且つ下劣な Academic Harassment を拝見します日本医学教育学会の学者は、決して歓迎されるものではありません。東京大学の元講師、京都大学の元准教授及び現特任教授、名古屋大学の現教授であられる錦織宏 学会理事長をはじめとする先生方におかれましては、ご自身に関わるこれまでの事実関係を真摯に受け止め、然るべき自制とご遠慮いただく方向で慎重、冷静にご考察いただけますと助かります。

重ねて申し上げますが、私は、三医会（国立三重大学医学科学閥）医師の様に白紙の医師診療録を基にした研究は行っておりません。また常勤勤務病院（91 床、さいたま市）にいらっしゃいます病院長をはじめとする 3 名の私立東京医大、「凡才」医師のごとく、鶏の様な下品で醜い勤務態度、小学生の様な話言葉、勤務中の TV Game 遊び並びにアニメ鑑賞、すなわち小学生 Level の医療を基に、医学教育、指導は行っておりません。念のため明記いたしまして、以下を結びの言葉に代えさせていただきます。

「他者にあたたく、論理にするどく、言葉を丁寧に使い、省察を重んじ、自由と独立を大事にし、時に権力と戦い、寛容であり、よい教育のために積極的に行動するコミュニティを、（日本医学教育学会会員の）皆さんと一緒に作っていきたいと考えています。」（日本医学教育学会の Website より）

いつもお世話になります。私 2009 年 8 月 31 日に日本医学教育学会に入会し 5 年間会員継続としてきましたが、2015 年学会会費期限 5 月 30 日をもちまして退会手続きとして下さい。日本医学教育学会退会の主な理由は、2012 年 1 月 26 日付「Chairperson 20th Anniversary Treatise」公表後も日本医学教育学会等から私（志田幸久、三重大学医学博士）への「Academic Harassment」が続き、これ以上の嫌がらせ抑制などのためです。三医会（三重大学医学部医学科学閥）からの「Academic Harassment」も 20 年間以上続いてまして、現在の東京首都圏での内科勤務が減少しますと、私老後の資金がなくなります。従いまして、2022 年頃までに作成予定でありました私の論文「Chairperson 20th Anniversary Treatise」の Full Paper も、この Academic Harassment によりまして残念ながら実現困難となりました。そして以下は、日本医学教育学会会員としまして、最後に日本医学教育学会にお伝えさせていただきます事項です。

上記は、私からの 2015 年 5 月 30 日付日本医学教育学会理事会宛文書「Paper on May 30, 2015 (Japan Society for Medical Education)」の序文です。お陰様で、学会を退会することによりまして東京首都圏での内科勤務を増やすことが出来ました。また 2018 年～2020 年の私の両親及び伯父さんからの遺産相続も加算されまして、2015 年 5 月 30 日学会退会 11 年後の本日 2026 年 7 月 31 日現在、国立東京大学 大学院医学研究科教授の年収 2,000 万円以上を、老後の資金として生涯確保済です。
