**Cocktail “Chairperson”
in Chicago and Takayama (Japan)**



Dear Assistant General Manager,

This is the first time for me to send a letter about our study to your hotel. I am the Doctor and Chairperson of Sports in Japan. It is my pleasure to introduce our academic homepage “**chairperson.jp**” which is visited from all over the world excluding China (?). For your information, I have informed about the “**Chairperson 20th Anniversary Treatise**” which is an unconventional style (not a full paper style) to the professors of the University of Tokyo in 2012, Harvard University in 2013, Oxford University in 2014 and Paris University in 2015 for the “**Doping-Backdoor Theory**,” the general managers or assistant general managers of hundreds of four or five-star hotels around the world for the “**Chairperson Cocktail**” and the regular members of the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra for “**My Way**” in (2010 and) 2016. “There are one and only theory and cocktail for universities and hotels in the 21st century.”

Two professors of the University of Tokyo gave their historical and traditional ‘Academic Harassment’ to me at the University of Tokyo. They dropped their head abruptly towards me on March 14 and May 22, 2012. For your reference, Fukushima University and my old school, Mie University are near first-class public universities which do not use the entrance-examination broker and 90% of the undergraduate students have a brain.

I am arranging the following travel itinerary: a business trip to Singapore from October 20 to 23, 2024. I received an email saying, “We are honored to welcome Dr. SHIDA as a member of Four Seasons Hotel Tokyo at Otemachi, on behalf of our entire staff,” on September 5, 2024. I still plan to join the Ark Hills Club in Tokyo, where I am looking for two current members to recommend me for membership.
